Women who themselves found peace after an abortion offer their support and hope. Small groups follow a nine-week biblical guidebook, <i>Transforming Your Story: A path to healing after abortion</i>, in which biblical stories intersect personal stories to bring healing and restoration.</p> <p>Groups are typically offered twice a year (spring and fall), and individual assistance is year-round. Currently groups are for women. The center also offers individual help for women and men.
